

SCSSA State Team Selection Criteria

(Effective 2016 skeet year)

The South Carolina Skeet Shooting Association (SCSSA) recognizes the State's top ranked shooters annually as called out in our By Laws. It is the SCSSA Vice Presidents responsibility to coordinate the designation of the SC State Team. The State Team shall consist of:

- The Top Ten SC Shooters as determined by 4 gun HoA
- The Top Concurrent shooters determined by 4 gun HoA in the categories of:

Lady's (2) Sub Junior (2), Junior (2), Collegiate, Triple Sub Senior, Sub Sub Senior, Sub Senior, Senior, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Military, Military Retired, Military Veteran.

Additional concurrent categories may be considered as designated by NSSA and as supported by their reporting.

The following criteria are used to designate the SC State Team for any given year:

- All SC State Team Inductees must :
 1. Be members in good standing with NSSA and the SCSSA
 2. Have successfully met SCSSA State Target Minimums as follows:

(*Note - All State Team Qualifying Targets must be shot at a NSSA / SCSSA registered shoot in which a NSSA certified referee presides. (Monthly and League targets **DO NOT QUALIFY** for meeting State Team Target minimums.) These minimums will be determined using NSSA compiled data for the shoot year.)

Qualifying shooters will be ranked by 4 gun HOA using NSSA scores for qualifying targets.

A shooter is eligible to win in both the Top Ten **and** in any applicable Concurrent Category they qualify for under the SCSSA Minimums as described above. An individual's Concurrent Category is determined by how they are registered with NSSA and as it displays on their membership card/Member profile. It is not the responsibility of the SCSSA to determine where a shooter might qualify – all calculations are made on NSSA provided data.

State Team Awards & Recognition

State Team Members will be listed each year in the SCSSA State Championship Program.

State Team Members will be recognized each year at the SC State Championship annual meeting or banquet

State Team Members will be recognized annually in the NSSA "Skeet Shooting Review".

Awards:

An engraved bronze SCSSA medal showing the team members name and annual average will be awarded each year to all State Team members. The medals are to be engraved as follows:.

A SCSSA belt buckle will be awarded any SCSSA member making the SC State Team "Top Ten" for the first time. The team member may select either an antique brass or two tone brass and silver buckle. In any subsequent year that member makes the state team they may elect to have the SCSSA Sec/Treasurer order them a buckle for which they will be billed.

The buckle will be engraved as such:

SC Skeet Shooting Assn <----- top of buckle
Rod Stroman 2004 State Team <----- bottom of buckle
