2017 Annual Meeting Minutes

The annual meeting of the SCSSA was called to order by Jim Gill, Friday evening, August 18th, 2016, at Greenville Gun Club.

The minutes of the 2016 meeting were presented and **approved**.

The Treasures report given and **approved**. The SCSSA balance as of July 31st was \$5,982.38.

1. Jim Gill initiated a discussion about SC State Fees and a potential increase.
 - o SC' s target fees as the lowest in the ZOne (1 cent while others are at least 2 cents)
 - o The Association is just treading water at the current rate
 - o Need to provide funding for HoF at Partridge Creek
 - o Could use to help support Youth Shooting Program (more to follow).

It was motioned to raise the State Fees to 2 cents per target starting in the 2018 Target Year. **Passed**

2. Jim Gill discussed the Zone Shoot. He provided a recap of the 2017 shoot and stated that we needed to host an i-Shoot location for 2018 Zone Shoot.

It was moved by Benji Turner and seconded by Sam Tupper that that the I-Zone location should follow the state shoot of the previous year – ie 2018 would be in Greenville, SC. The motion **passed** unanimously.

3. Jim discussed the need for qualified referees at all the SCSSA shoots that are knowledgeable of the rules. Clubs were encouraged to use paid referees if needed and not rely solely on shooting referees or letting some squads self referee. He said there is no difference in the cost. Jim also stated that we need to develop more qualified referees.

Youth Program

Youth Camp at Greenville Gun Club was very successful.

4H & SCTP are requesting that the SCSSA sponsor a scholarship. Based on membership response it was determined we would not do anything at this time.
