Annual Champion of Champions Award

Criteria

The South Carolina Skeet Shooting Association (SCSSA) each year recognizes the South Carolina State Champion of Champions (Champ of Champs). It is the SCSSA Secretary / Treasurer's responsibility to coordinate the designation of the SC Champ of Champs.

The Champ of Champs is awarded at the SCSSA Annual State Skeet Shoot. An individual must be a SCSSA member and SC resident to be eligible.

To qualify to compete for the award an individual must win an HOA or gun championship at any South Carolina registered skeet shoot since and including the previous year's State Championships.

Qualifying shooters will have their scores tracked during the SCSSA Annual State Skeet Shoot to determine the ultimate champ. The scores from the fourth round in each of the four gauges will be added together to establish a Champ of Champs score. The Participant highest score will be awarded as the Champ of Champs. Ties will be resolved by shoot offs - doubles from stations 3, 4, and 5. Miss and out by station.

"Champion of Champions" belt buckles will be awarded each year to winner and a runner-up.

The buckle will be engraved as such:

2004 Champion of Champions <----- bottom of buckle

And

Runner up
